Portable Arena's

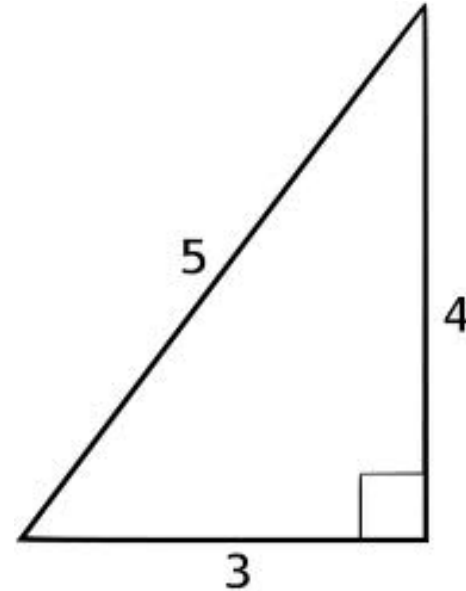
Each 60x20 arena consists of the following:

40	4m rails (39 needed)
2	1m Rails – to bring opening to regulation 2m wide
38	Line Cones
4	Corner Cones
12	Letters

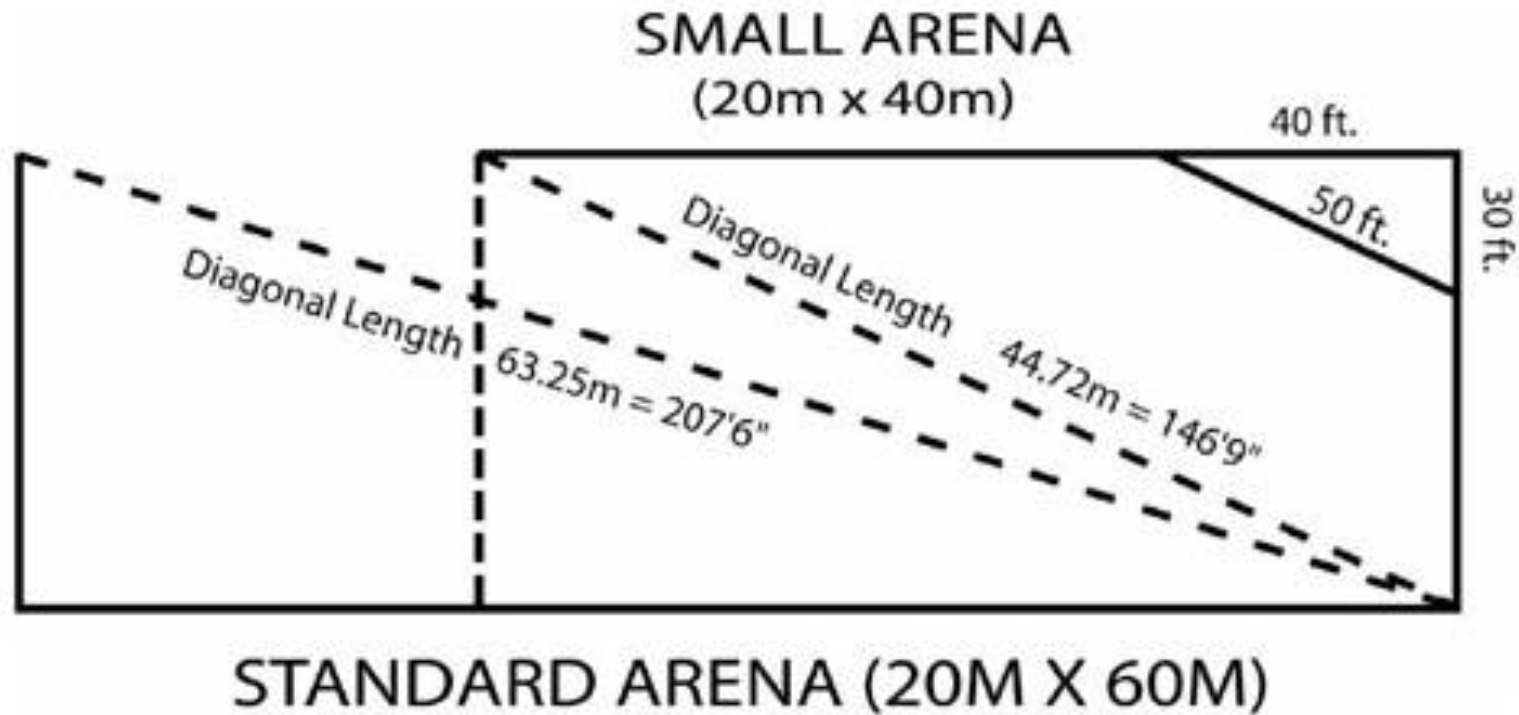
Total items for 4 arena's

160	4m rails (4 spares)
8	1m Rails
152	Line Cones
16	Corner Cones
48	Letters

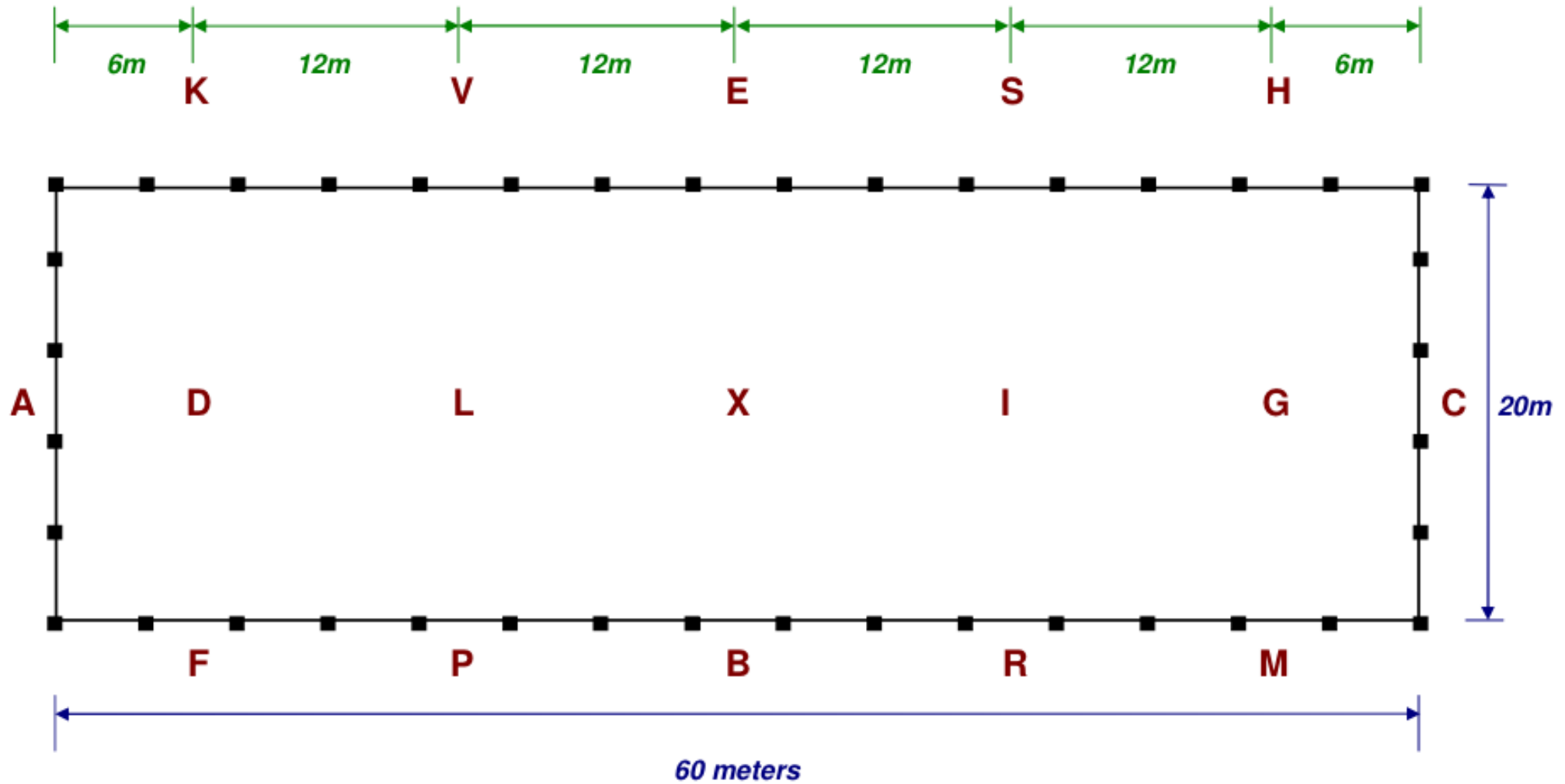
A 90° corner is established by using the Pythagorean theorem, which states that the sum of the squares of the sides of a right triangle equals the square of the hypotenuse. Tapes are used to establish a right triangle with sides of 4 meters and 3 meters and a hypotenuse of 5 meters.



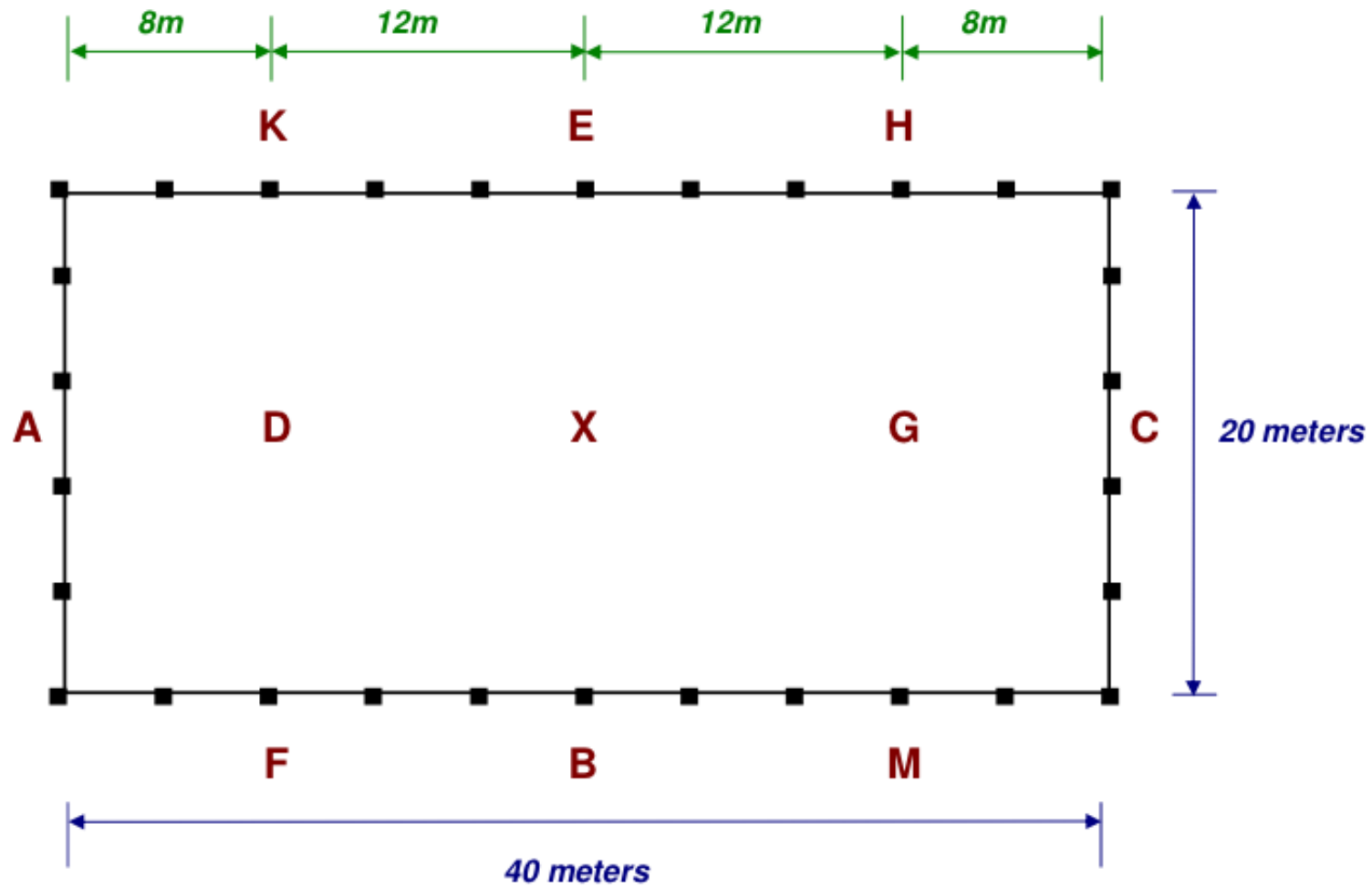
Setting Up Arena – Square Corner

Slide 1 row of letter cones out at a time

Unload Letter Cones



Move away base flange



Lift all cones up



Move base out and lower

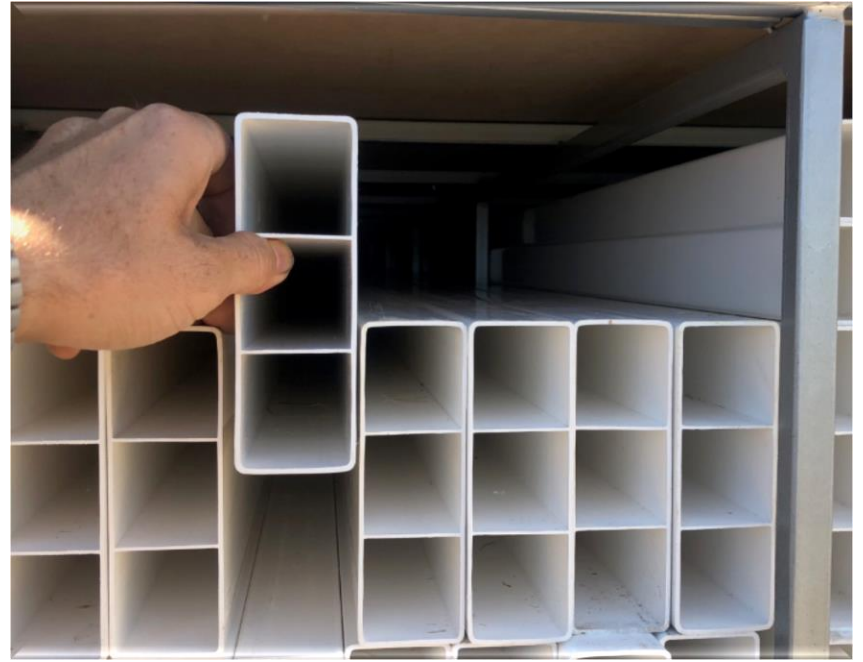


Take caution not to hit side of trailer

Unloading Line and Corner Cones



Lift 1 rail



Pull out towards you
