#### **Zone Rep Report from Sue Foley**

Hello All,

First and foremost congratulations to each and every member of the Midland Zone Teams and their support crews who made the journey through the dreaded tunnel to the PCAV State Show jumping and Dressage Championships held at Wonthaggi PC grounds over the weekend of February  $21^{\rm st}$  and  $22^{\rm nd}$ . Our riders all rode beautifully. The ribbons were the icing on the cake.

The team spirit, camaraderie and friendship shared among everyone connected with the Midland Zone was everything. It was a wonderful weekend of equestrian competition.

Our results were also very impressive

The B grade show jumping team with Anna Parry riding 2 horses, Brianne Cole and Chelsea Gerring came 4th. The C grade show jumping team with Hannah Wigg riding 2 horses, Sam Palmer and Alex Kelly came 6<sup>th</sup>. The grade 2 dressage team of Tahlia Wilson, Steph Horton and Shaleah Bray came 6<sup>th</sup>. Well done also to our Grade 1 individual dressage riders, Laura Grinton and Marissa Norris and our grade 3 team Sammi Browell, Mikayla O'Neill and Molly Gould.

#### **State Council business**

There has been a bit of unsureness and resistance to 2 new policies implemented by State Council, the first being the registration of all coaches/instructors who teach at a pony club rally.

Coaches have always been registered on the PCAV State Database but previously this has happened via Club Secretaries during the Annual Membership Return period. Club Secretaries were responsible for completing the "Instructor Summary Form" however sometimes this didn't happen or the details provided were not always accurate or complete. So ... the way we are gathering information on our coaches in changing.

Clubs need to register any person who coaches at Pony Club, be they paid or a volunteer, they must be registered with PCAV to be considered a registered and approved coach.

This needs to happen for many reasons including improved communication, statistics, better targeting of resources, risk management and insurance requirements. If you are a coach but not registered as a coach on the PCAV Database you will not be covered by our insurance policy for your coaching activities.

All Coaches, including Preliminary Coaches and other Coaches, approved by PCAV have Public & Products Liability up to \$20,000,000, with an excess of \$1,000 third party property damage for claims relating to your legal liability to compensate third parties for personal injury or property damage. The second bone of contention is the changes implemented to those pony club members who need to have a Working with Children's Check.

As per the State Council update Feb. 2015 on the PCAV home page:

The following motion was passed by State Council at the November 2014 State Council meeting. It is a proactive decision designed to provide a duty of care to all PCAV members. The WWCC Legislation outlines minimum mandated requirements; organisations can broaden their policy and widen the field beyond those listed by The Department of Justice to protect the children/youth in their respective fields. That from July 1st 2015 clubs must ensure that all parents/guardians/carers of members and members over 18 must provide a current WWCC.

I have received some queries about who needs to have the WWCC. One club asked about Grandparents and the parents of riders who Come and Try.

Grandparents who occasionally come to watch at pony club are exempt as are the parents of children who attend a Come and Try rally. These people should sign the club registration book to prove their attendance in case of an incident that could later involve an insurance claim.

They also asked about people who don't qualify for a WWCC. From what I have read the only people who would fail a WWCC are those that the Department of Justice & Regulation deems to "pose a risk to the safety of children".

A WWCC is relatively easy to apply for. The check can be applied for online and it is free for volunteers. I believe it is also a simple process to admin at club level.

Every member of pony club has to reapply to join their club in the new financial year which means filling in a new application form. The internal club forms are available from the PCAV website and can be amended to suit your club by also adding columns for the WWCC information.

The club secretary will need to advise all relevant members of the need for them to have a WWCC by the time annual club fees are due.

The rule for the WWCC is no different to the many other rules that we have in the PCAV Hand Book of Bylaws. The rule has been implemented as PCAV is being pro-active as an organization and recognises that we have a duty of care to our riders to anticipate and avoid risk to the children.

Insurance is put at risk if clubs fail to abide by our rules and all clubs should follow PCAV rules and directives. Litigation will be no different for this than for any other rule that a club does not abide by. A WWCC should form part of a clubs risk management and if you have taken every care as a club to provide a safe environment for your club by complying with the rules then the club will be fine. An incident can also come from someone who has passed a WWCC but at least as a club you have done all you can to provide a safe environment for your riders.

#### C Certificate

Nicki is on holidays so is not with us this evening. She has been working on a Certificate information sheet to go to all clubs to better explain the process of the "C" certificate. This information will be sent to clubs in the very near future.

All clubs should please add the C certificate dates to their club calendars at the beginning of each New Year so that members can plan around the examination dates.

#### NCAS dates

There has been information sent by Kate from head office to clubs about the upcoming NCAS Training & Assessment @ Stawell Pony Club on the weekend of the 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> April.

The program and entry form is out for the Horseland State Horse Trials Championships 2015 to be held at Rosedale on the first weekend in May. Another long drive including the tunnel! The InterZone Team 3 and 4 challenge is to be held at the Pony Club Victoria Equestrian Centre and while it is a bit of a drive for those of us in the outer Zones once we have done it once or twice we will become familiar with it and it will be easier than going to unknown destinations all the time I attended my first horse trials as Zone rep last weekend at Dunolly run by Bealiba PC. It was a great day of competition and I can tick off Horse Trial briefing from my "Firsts" list. I am on a steep learning curve and I thank Linda and the rest of the Zone exec for their help and of course Kay who thank goodness is only ever a phone call away.

## **Zone Chief Instructor Report from Nicki Chalmers**

PCAV State Council has implemented a process for unpaid volunteer coaches to become a registered coach without paying a fee. Volunteer coaches are those that receive no reimbursements for coaching, time & travel. Such coaches need to be registered via their zone or club; all other coaches must continue to register online. Instructions and the templates required to complete the registration process should have been received by clubs already.

The scheduled NCAS weekend for April 18th & 19th will be held at Stawell Pony Club grounds. It will be run as our zone has previously run these weekends, with training on the Saturday and Assessment on the Sunday. Both prelim and Level 1 will be catered for, and current coaches may use the Saturday for updating. Full information and bookings can be made on the PCAV website. If anyone has any questions or requires any assistance with their workbooks etc. they are welcome to contact me. Coach E-News has just begun, and will be distributed to registered coaches, persons registered with NCAS books and club officials. These will communicate training opportunities & news to our coaches, however, it is important that club officials still discuss these with members to continue to encourage up and coming coaches who may not yet receive such information.
