Zone Rep Report from Sue Foley

Hi All,

At the State Council meeting last Tuesday Suanne from head office conducted a virtual guided tour around the My Pony Club data base, in particular explaining everything that can be done from a Zone to Club perspective. It was explained that it is a great tool for communication including the option to link Facebook pages and to also send sms to all MZ members. It also has the option to send bulk emails and will then report on how many of them have been opened so as soon as we get up to speed on how to use it we will begin to do so

To this end it is important that all members of our zone have current information on their member profile. Zone reps were asked to remind clubs to please ensure that all adult club supporters are registered and understand the need to access their member profile. He said "Sue, these composite teams are the best cos you don't know who you are playing with then you make new friends." What a great attitude!

It is sad that we had not even a one pairs team compete on the day. I have thought long and hard about this and I would like to encourage club DC's to plan the rally year before the start of the year as much as possible. This includes talking to riders about the events that are coming up throughout the year. It means encouraging them to participate and it means talking to riders and their families about what team events they can enter and what is needed to make it happen. - Thanks from Viv Cole for flowers and Cards on the passing of Zone life member Laurie Cole
- Mandurang South asked if riders that have been *asked* to go to state Games in composite Teams (that did not ride at the Zone competition) pay half price like those that did qualifying event. The answer is no (this is a Zone Rule).
- Moved Sue Foley, Seconded Chelsea Gerring that Zone move the working bank account from Australia Bank to Bendigo Bank for ease of Access for clubs to deposit cheques. The current situation is very difficult for access to Bank Australia, whereas the Bendigo have branches throughout the community.
 Signatories for the account to be Treasurer Debra Maree Weir, President Linda Gerring, Zone Rep Susan Kaye Foley. Any two of three to sign or authorise as required. Motion Carried
- Moved Sue Foley, Seconded Viv Cole that Debbie Weir be authorised to be able to access the Midland Zone "My Pony Club". Motion Carried
- Kaye Blanchard discussed the responsibilities of the Zone Rep, lack of respect for the zone rep who is responsible for our zone applying the rules of PCV and also asked if the zone might look at getting the "training" changed for the led riders at state level rules committee. Sue discussed the PCV rules and formal competition and training differences, and that it's all in the wording, but riders cannot be led in Graded competitions- i.e. Dressage and Show jumping.
- Discussion in regards to the Pony Club ring ran by the Bendigo Show and other Ag Shows. Running without gear checks and Card checks and using the PC name to make money. Letter to be sent to Bendigo Show Committee, offering support of our members to organise and support the event with the Show Committee so that the event can be better ran in future years.
