# Change to show jumping rules

Discussion was held on the merits of changing rules with regard to heights.

- Obstacle dimensions for both disciplines have been used successfully for many years and to change them is unnecessary.
- Most of the uncertainty exists with the parents and riders competing at the lower grades.
- There is anecdotal evidence to suggest that some clubs automatically grade riders for Grade 5 and PE show jumping without really considering this difference.
- It is felt that some members and parents are unaware that younger Grade 5 riders graded "PE" are jumping the equivalent of Grade 3 cross country dimensions.

# Moved – L. Gerring that a new show jumping grade of "PF" be introduced with a maximum starting height of 45cm and maximum finishing height of 53 cm.
