## Zone Rep Report – 10/2/26

---

Welcome everyone to the 2026 Pony Club year. Many clubs are now back in action following the break. State Zone Advisory Panel meetings will be held monthly this year rather than the usual bi-monthly schedule. Our first meeting for the year was held last week.

Preparations for the State Showjumping and Dressage Championships, to be held at Warrnambool on 21–22 February, are progressing well. Entries closed on Monday and today reserve riders were balloted and positions offered. I was advised today that all yards are now fully booked. Any riders who have not secured a yard will be required to BYO. Alternatively, a club located approximately 30 minutes from the grounds has offered free use of their facilities.

I can also confirm that the grounds are being watered in preparation for the event. A Rider's Retreat lounge will be available for competitors to escape the heat and there is nearby beach access for riders wishing to cool their horses.

A significant portion of the meeting related to rules. As these have not yet been approved, I cannot go into specifics. However, there was discussion around expanding horse abuse rules to better align with EA and FEI standards. Topics included jumping from a standstill, blood in the mouth and excessive whip use. There was considerable discussion around how to balance our role as an educational organisation while clearly reinforcing that horse welfare is of utmost importance and ill-treatment will not be tolerated. As a result, the aim is to implement on-the-spot penalties supported by a clear and simple warning system.

There was also further discussion regarding Victorian whip rules following feedback from members. Currently, national gear rules base whip length on pony or horse height, whereas Victoria bases whip length on rider grade. As many members refer only to the national rules, this has caused confusion. Zones have been asked to provide feedback on whether Victoria should remain grade-based or align with the national horse-height system.

Concerns were raised regarding new charges for coaches attending state workshops for assessment, including a \$150 fee for trainee coaches. Many members who previously purchased the coaching resources were advised that assessment costs were included. It appears this change was implemented without consultation. Efforts are

underway to rectify this and ensure that those affected are treated in line with the conditions under which they originally enrolled.

I have also received questions regarding changes to helmet standards. It was confirmed that PCA has advised an update is pending following a Safety Committee meeting this week. New rules are expected but not yet confirmed. Current helmets remain compliant at this time and it is anticipated that any changes will be introduced gradually. I would also like to highlight the importance of relying on official PCA communications rather than information provided by retail staff, as misinformation can sometimes be circulated.

## **MIDLAND ZONE Chief Instructors Report February 2026**

---

1. **Coach training and assessment weekend.** 22/23 November, in Castlemaine. Activities covered were Lunging, Including the Syllabus into lessons, Jumping lines and poles. These topics were put forward from members of Midland Zone. It was great to see many of our zone coaches attending the Saturday sessions and we had a good number of trainee coaches gain their coaching accreditation on the Sunday. There was great feedback from the weekend through the PCV feedback questionnaire. Our next Coach training and assessment weekend will be again in November this year.
2. **B Certificate** – Asha Fiedler (Horsham Pony Club) and myself travelled to Warnambool in the Wannoon Zone on the weekend of January 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> for our B Certificate Assessments.

Asha was able to achieve her B Certificate fully (with the jumping version of 95cm), over the weekend, with myself needing to go back to jump an 85cm show jumping course.

The B Certificate consisted of an online exam, to which candidates need to achieve 80% or higher to pass, and submit a journal on a new skill. (non jumping version of the B Certificate)

Written journal of their journey with their horse, covering training, competitions, day to day care, feed, vet, coaching, farriering, etc etc costs. Heart and temperature readings also need to be shown amongst lots of things, which is over 1 or two years.

Other components were knowledge and demonstration of the rules for show jumping and cross country along with course design. Candidates are required to submit a show jumping course and set it up, and walk the course and discuss it with the assessors.

Lunging, complete with side reins, ground work, extensive veterinary kit, bandaging with blanket stitch, feeding, float maintenance, riding on the flat, assessment riding an unfamiliar horse are all part of the assessment too.

It was two very long days, but an overall wonderful experience to be a part of to not only be able to showcase my skills learned over my life, but also to have gain knowledge of many new ones.

Asha and Paris Fiedler will now begin their A Certificate journey.

3. **Grant Funding Application** – Linda Gerring has applied for a Government Grant for funding to run coaching clinics throughout the year to cover costs associated with travel and accommodation and facilitator costs. We are yet to find out if we were successful in this. More of this later. Many thanks to Linda for submitting this for me.
